This term we have a few new faces around our site, or more specifically in our Preschool. I'd like to extend a welcome to Hayley Bell, who has taken on the Preschool teacher role for the next two terms. Hayley is an experienced educator, and has come to us from Millicent North Kindergarten. Already I can see the positive relationships that Hayley is building with our children and it's exciting to welcome another smiling face to our team. Giulia McKenzie joins Hayley on Thursdays, supporting our littlest learners as they play, grow and explore.

Term 3 is the first mid-year intake for preschool children, and I welcome Molly, Xander, Wyatt, Bonnie and Heidi to Beachport Primary School and Preschool. These children are settling in quickly and building important relationships with their educators, preschool peers and buddies throughout the school.

The beginning of term has been a busy time for our staff team, with lots of Professional Development and learning occurring. On our Pupil Free Day we attended a Literacy Day, aimed at developing vocabulary, teaching the history of the English language and Cognitive Load. Last week we welcomed staff from the Small Schools Collaborative for our Numeracy PLC Days, collaborating about the ways that we can intentionally structure each learning activity to cater for every student in our class, whilst continuing to incorporate Learning Intentions and Success Criteria into our routines and lessons. We also dived deeply into types of evidence that we collect to analyse student progress, and how we utilise these pieces of evidence to inform our planning, and to work with students to identify next steps within their learning journey. So much exciting learning!

Over the holidays the Junior Primary and Middle Primary classes also had new Promethean Interactive Boards installed in their classrooms. These new boards provide updated technology and opportunity to incorporate even more interactive elements and resources into our teaching and learning.

As you can see, it's been an exciting start to term and there are many things to look forward to over the coming weeks. Next week we hold our first assembly for Term 3, and every Friday at 3pm (starting week 4) we will have a whole school get together to add names to our Beachport Bookworm, and to present weekly CARE Awards. These get togethers will be at the Bike Shed (weather allowing) so please feel free to pop in a little earlier and join us on Fridays. On Monday we also have our first Governing Council meeting of the term, so please touch base with one of your friendly Council members if you would like an update or if you're interested in joining our Council.

I'm looking forward to another super busy and exciting term!


